



Regulations of 3rd MUB's International Karaoke Night

02.02.2023

I. Purpose:

The main goals of 3rd MUB's International Karaoke Night are:

- organization of the 3rd MUB's International Karaoke Night with the participation of international MUB's community
- cultivation of the attitude of openness and tolerance
- decreasing intercultural barriers
- building relationships in the academic community of the Medical University of Białystok by singing together
- contributing to improvement of the image of the Medical University of Białystok
- as an institution open to international cooperation, caring for the comfort of foreigners studying and working at the Medical University of Białystok

II. Organizer:

The organizer of the 3rd MUB's International Karaoke Night is the Medical University of Białystok and Bonsai – Artistic Agency Radosław Krysiak is the implementing entity.

III. Form:

3rd MUB's International Karaoke Night is about organizing karaoke event for members of the MUB academic community: scientific and administrative employees, local and international students, doctoral students and graduates.

IV. Participants:

3rd MUB's International Karaoke Night is intended for employees, students, doctoral students and graduates of the Medical University of Białystok. The maximum number of event participants - 250 people.

V. Place and date:

Place: Loft Club at Marii Skłodowskiej-Curie 2 street in Białystok

Date: 02.02.2023 (Thursday)

VI. Registration:

Applications for active participation in the International Karaoke Night competition will be made only via the registration form on the website: http://event-bonsai.pl/karaoke_night/ from 03.01.23 to 25.01.23.

In case of problems with registration, please report your willingness to participate in the event to the e-mail address: urszula.roszkowska@umb.edu.pl There will be no need to submit paper application forms. The entrant will be able to select ONLY ONE song from the track list, or select their own song suggestion to add to the track list.

Each participant taking part in the competition will receive an e-mail confirming participation in the event. The organizer reserves the right to close the recruitment process earlier if the number of applications exceeds the time available for the competition part of the event or the planned limit of participants. Applications for participation in the event (without participation in the karaoke competition) will be possible from from 03.01.23 to 25.01.23 also at the link http://event-bonsai.pl/karaoke_night/ (subject to available places), Sending an application is tantamount to acceptance of these regulations.

VII. Schedule:

02.02.2023 in Loft Club at Marii Skłodowskiej-Curie 2 street in Białystok From 18:30 till 02:00 (the next day)

19:00 – „Name that tune” contest

19:30 – start of the event, official opening by MUB’s representative

19:45 – start of the karaoke contest

21:45 (approximately, depending on the amount of the participants and songs lengths) – award ceremony

22:00 (approximately) – start of the dance party

02:00 (03.02.2023) – end of the event

VIII. Participation:

The event participant who is a student will be required to show a student ID at the entrance of the club where the list with the names of the participants will be checked. Before entering the club, each participant of the event will receive a wristband confirming participation.

IX. Contest classification:

There will be classification into solo category and group category. A 4-person competition jury consisting of representatives of e.g. foreign students, domestic students, authorities and academic teachers (one representative from each group) will be appointed, which will evaluate the performances and award individual persons / groups;; in addition to the prizes, the jury will also award an audience award based on a ballot box vote during the event. The jury will select the winners who will be placed 1-3 in each of these two categories:

I. Solo category:

Songs from different countries, e.g. German song, English song, Norwegian song, Swedish song, Arabic song, Indian song, Spanish song, Polish song, etc.

* Where, for example, a German song means that the author of this song is an artist / band from Germany. The song does not necessarily have to be sung in German, it can be performed in another language.

II. Group category:

Best performed songs in a duo, trio or quartet (regardless of language / country).

X. Results and awards:

- there will be a competition "Name that tune", in which competitors will be able to win 30 - tickets (vouchers) to the cinema in Białystok

- the competition jury consisting of representatives of e.g. foreign students, domestic students, authorities and academic teachers (one representative from each group) will evaluate the performances and award individual persons / groups- in-kind prizes will be given to the winners according to the following specifications:

- 1st place: external hard disk
- 2nd place: alarm clock radio
- 3rd place: power bank
- Audience award - vouchers for dinner in one of Białystok's restaurants with a total value of PLN 400

XI. Final Provisions:

- the organizer is not responsible for items left unattended
- the organizer reserves the right to use, free of charge, all photos, videos, interviews and audio recordings of the event participants around the world
- by signing up for the competition and taking part in the event, the participant accepts the regulations
- all participants are bound by these regulations
- the organizer is not responsible for errors in declarations of will and declarations provided by the participant / concerns, inter alia, submitted personal data of the participant, etc.
- participants undertake to accept the following statements:

I declare, that:

- I am more than 18 years old
- I have read the regulations of the 2nd International Karaoke Night MUB and I accept its provisions

I acknowledge that:

- the administrator of my personal data is the Medical University of Białystok, with its seat at ul. Kilińskiego 1, 15-089 Białystok, represented by the Rector

- my personal data will be processed in order to conduct the 2nd MUB's International Karaoke Night pursuant to art. 6 sec. 1 lit. and the general regulation on the protection of personal data of April 27, 2016. (GDPR), i.e. consent given voluntarily by sending the application form,
- the registration process takes place via a Google form, so your data is stored by Google. If you do not wish to register via the Google form, please contact us by e-mail: biuro@event-bonsai.pl
- my personal data will be made available only to the contractor of the event organization, i.e. the Event Bonsai event agency, which cooperates with MUB on the basis of a personal data entrustment agreement
- my personal data will be stored until May 31, 2024.
- I have the right to access my data, the right to rectify it, the right to transfer data, to delete data, the right to limit processing, the right to object - on the terms set out in the GDPR,



- I have the right to withdraw my consent at any time, consent can be withdrawn, e.g. by sending an email to the following address: urszula.roszkowska@umb.edu.pl
- I have the right to lodge a complaint with the President of the Personal Data Protection Office, ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw, when it is justified that my personal data is processed by the administrator contrary to the general regulation on the protection of personal data of 27 April 2016.
- providing data is voluntary but necessary to conduct the International Karaoke Night of the MUB
- on the basis of the personal data provided, no automated decisions will be made, including profiling.

XII. Safety:

- Participants are asked to line up in front of the club building with a distance of 1.5 m
- The presentation of the vaccination certificate by the event participant is voluntary. This procedure is due to different limits on the number of vaccinated and unvaccinated people at mass events.
- Participants are required to disinfect their hands at the club entrance and each time before using the buffet. Disinfectants with instructions for effective hand washing and disinfection will be available in changing rooms and toilets and in every public room for the public in a visible place
- security will be provided during the club party. Security staff will be equipped with appropriate personal protective equipment (masks, hand disinfectants)
- Fire safety instructions describing the conditions of evacuation from the Club, specifying the maximum number of people who may stay on the premises of the facility, as well as measurement protocols of emergency and evacuation lighting and electrical installation will be at the disposal of both MUB and the person conducting the event. The club will meet the requirements of fire protection and health and safety, which will be previously confirmed in writing by the contractor of the event and submitted to the MUB
- the manner of announcing the evacuation alarm - giving the message "Warning, danger! I order the evacuation. You should go outside to the meeting point. " using the club's sound system)
- in the event of an evacuation announcement, the event participant undertakes to act in accordance with the instructions for action in case of fire and to follow the instructions of the security. In the case of an ordered evacuation, follow the marked routes and emergency exits in accordance with the easy-access evacuation plan. After leaving the club, he / she undertakes to stay in the designated evacuation place until the decision is made by the action leader from the appropriate rescue service



- the meeting point after evacuation from the club is the area in front of the club entrance at Marii Skłodowskiej-Curie 2 street next to the Central shopping mall, leaving the assembly point for evacuees, only with the consent of the action leader from the relevant rescue service
- the participant undertakes to comply with the basic safety and fire safety rules
- it is forbidden to bring flammable substances, it is forbidden to smoke tobacco products and electronic cigarettes outside designated places
- it is forbidden to bring weapons or other dangerous objects, explosives, pyrotechnic products, fire-hazardous materials, alcoholic beverages, intoxicants or psychotropic substances
- the participant undertakes to comply with the club's safety regulations and the regulations of the event
- any breaches of the security regulations will result in the removal of the participant from the event and the possibility of imposing a penalty
- fire safety instructions with a list of emergency numbers are located in visible places in the club
- the regulations of the event will be available in paper form at the club and in electronic form on the event website

XIII. Entering the 3rd MUB's International Karaoke Night event equals the acceptance of the terms of the regulations written above.

The organizer reserves the right to change the regulations in accordance with the guidelines of the Ministry of Health, the Ministry of Culture and National Heritage, and the Chief Sanitary Inspectorate for organizers of cultural and entertainment events during the SARS-CoV-2 virus epidemic in Poland.
